November 12th, 2009 Town Council Meeting -4:30pm

1. Council President Brent Shull called the meeting to order at 4:30pm.

Roll call: Councilors Jeff Bireley, John Damron, Will Nuttle, and Brent Shull were present. The Clerk Treasurer, Hester Stouder was present to record the meeting.

Also present was Town Manager Milton Otero and Town Attorney Dan Brinkerhoff, absent members included Dick Bacon. Attached is a list of audience members.

2. Selling a Firearm – Council President Brent Shull explained to the board Marshal Joe Patterson would like to purchase one of his Firearms. After doing some research the appropriate price was found to be \$300.00 to include the \$25.00 transfer fee. After a brief discussion, Councilman Jeff Bireley made the motion to approve this transfer and purchase for the gun mentioned, John Damron seconded the motion, motion carried. Councilman Shull requested that the transfer be complete by the end of November, Town Manager Milton Otero assured him it would be and will be working with Joe Patterson to make sure it happens.

3. New/Old Business -

- A. Mr. Bireley asked what the status was on the downtown dumpster project? Mr. Otero said he recently had a total of 4 businesses back out, changing the cost for those still wanting to be involved. Mr. Otero said he would be waiting on reply's and commitment from others and if he didn't get a concrete group by the deadline he gave of November 13, 2009 he would ask the council at the December meeting to abandon the project at this time.
- B. Councilman Bireley asked if there was any interest in the Downtown Parking lot project on Lake Street. Mr. Otero said he had made contact with several contractors and would be sending out close to 6-bid request to various other contractors. The deadline for turning in bids will be November 30th at 3:00pm. They will be presented at the December meeting.
- C. Councilman John Damron said he felt requiring employees and elected officials to make sure it is locked could solve the back door discussion and would be less expensive than the alternative of replacing the door or locks. Town Manager Otero said he got a price from Larry's Lock & Safe for about \$700.00 to install a new locking system. He is still getting more information together and will present it to the council at the next scheduled meeting.

With no other comments or items of business, the motion to adjourn was made by John Damron and seconded by Will Nuttle. The meeting adjourned at 4:42 pm.
